Meeting Notes:

- 1) Debbie proposed that we approve meeting minutes from April 2014; Motion – John Hughes, 2nd – Kristie Ruesch, motion carried by all.
- 2) John showed the council a video about how SCC funds are collected from Trust lands and distributed to schools.
- 3) This year ATEC SCC received \$5,984 in money this school year; \$2,935.72 carryover balance from last year. The question was raised about how much can be carried over. It is required that a minimum of 90% of the budget must be used this school year. A carryover plan can be made for more, if a long-term plan is presented that is approved.
- 4) Debbie proposed that a secretary position be elected; Motion – John, 2nd – Liz Cameron, motion carried by all.
- 5) John proposed that we approve meeting minutes from September 2014; Motion – John Hughes, 2nd – Kristie Ruesch, motion carried by all.
- 6) Status of current School Improvement Plan; John explained that iPads were purchased to conduct video modeling; Kristie showed the iMovies that were created with the iPads last year; there is about \$2,000 leftover from what was budgeted for the iPads that can be carried over or used for related items.
- 7) Toured the Sensory room to see the kinds of items currently in the room and discussed possible items for future purchase; Brandon made a motion to spend \$2000 of the carryover money from the IPAD purchase to use for Sensory Room items for this year, 2nd – Kristie, carried by all; DISCUSS with teachers the possible purchase a Wii and other items that they feel would be important to add to the Sensory room; Erika Lopez showed the group the balametrics.com website and suggested purchasing a balance board to use in the Sensory Room
- 8) Other items
 - a. Jamie suggested Google glasses
 - b. Paulina talked about learning to do math and money skills
- 9) Parent and Student Survey – John, Debbie, and Jamie will prepare a survey to go out December 1st
- 10) John will check on Family to Family Network; Jamie wants to see more Family Involvement and do monthly activities that parents and students can attend and build comrade among the families – John will talk to the PTA
