## **Meeting Notes:**

- Reviewed Last Meeting Notes

- Discussion regarding ideas for next year's plan:
  - Classroom Aide Around \$11,890.20 for wages and Insurance at \$11.08 per hour
    - If aide wasn't hired before 2013
    - Total funds available are estimated to be about \$13,000 14,000
  - Summer Collaboration no longer \$3,567, but \$892 now.
  - o Estimated Total: 12,782.20
  - o This year's estimated amount (Last Year's allocation + carryover) would be \$12,670.43
  - If fund available:
    - Support goals 1 and 2
    - Support library with books, software, and tech & sensory needs of students
  - If funds aren't available:
    - \$111.77 shortfall will be allocated from school funds professional development funds
  - Motion to approve plan by Nancy Christiansen, seconded by Peggy Howell and unanimously approved.
- Question by Nancy Christiansen: Do we have an idea for who we'd like to use as a floating sub?
  - John Hughes responded: Not yet, but we'll be hiring and it will be a rotational
- Internet Safety: Permission to use the presentation from another school will be obtained by John Hughes
  - Students are only allowed onto certain sites here at school but we want to address concerns that may come up in their lives away from school
    - Giving out personal info., friends on social media, etc.
    - Catfishing should be reported to the social media site, it is a crime
      - An idea to protect against this is to have the unknown person send a picture of themselves holding a written note saying something prearranged.
    - Sarah Ah and Whisper are brutally honest sites that some students have been accessing.
- Terrorism at school
  - Students feel very nervous about the possibility of this occurring
  - We have a lockdown drill each year to get ready
