Dear Parents,

We have had several meetings in regards to graduation and the end of school procedures last week. I later met with all the secondary principals in the district and together we came up with a cohesive plan district-wide that will be pretty awesome.

As a school, we met again this morning and we are so very pleased with what we have created for graduation and celebrating seniors for CVHS. You will see things as they unfold! Just today, we received our fuselage from Duncan Aviation! If you have not seen it, go take a look at our social media sites! Also, be on the lookout to bake with me my famous chocolate chip cookies! You will never find a better cookie! When I get back home, we will start baking!

Please read below this very important information.

1. Important Graduation Survey: Alpine School District will be sending out two surveys on MONDAY: one to parents and one to students. One of the questions on the survey will address graduation. It is REALLY important that you take some time to respond to this survey if you have a senior attending CVHS, it is equally important that your senior student responds. The student survey will arrive in their school account and sometimes students do not monitor their school account, so please have them watch for this survey.

The voices of parents and students are important to us, and Alpine School District will make a decision accordingly.

2. Student pick-up of items: We will be sending out a procedural process for students to claim projects in Art, Wood Shop, etc. This will mostly be coordinated through teachers of specific classes. Watch for the procedures soon.

3. Student return of items: Same as item 2. We are really not in a great hurry to get things back right now.

4. Refunds:

- Spring Athletics: We are working with coaches to determine what was spent or not. We will know this week and will communicate with you when we have made a final decision.

5. Grades: ASD is exploring alternative grading procedures. The intent is to "do no harm" to students. ASD School Board will be reviewing proposals, and you will be notified of these changes on Wednesday. ASD is working on a fair process

that takes a lot of things into consideration. We understand that this is a really bizarre situation, and there is a lot of stress and anxiety regarding grades.

6. Grab and go Meals: I sent out the changes to the Grab-and-Go Meal distribution process on Instagram, Facebook, and Twitter. I am attaching a summary for your reference in case you missed it.

7. Field Use: We will begin opening the stadium for use from about 8:00 am - 6:00 pm. We ask that you respect the governor's social distancing guidelines. We have had trouble with dogs pooping on the field, damage to the turf, food on the turf (which invalidates the warranty on the turf), knocked over garbage cans, vandalism and general misuse of the facility.

Please help us monitor use, so we can offer the use of the stadium for students and patrons. Please adhere to the following:

- Dogs are NOT allowed in the stadium.
- Keep social distancing
- Group practices or pick up games are NOT allowed (this violates social distancing and the UHSAA rules of their Moratorium)
- No food
- Only water on the turf

We do not want to have to close the facility as many municipalities have done with playgrounds.
