#### Goals for 2011-2012

## 1-Increase graduation rates

(It was mentioned that this is based on 10<sup>th</sup> grade enrollment; this is different than in the past, so in the future the numbers will be a little skewed until they have done it this way for a few years.)

Hired 2 advocates to mentor at risk students and added math aides

In the last three years our graduation rate has gone from 77.1% to 84.8%

# 2-Improve pass rates

An advocate was hired to help low performing students

After School programs added

Latinos in Action

### **3-Improve Math Rates**

Reduced math class sizes

Added an AP Calculus class-Our math scores CRT score average went up 10% from 55% to 65%

### **4-AP Classes**

Additional AP Calculus Class 97% Pass Rate

AP History 39 enrolled 21 tested 67% passed

AP Spanish 26 enrolled 9 tested 66% passed (It was mentioned that this test is extremely difficult unless you are an ESL student)

AP German 9 enrolled 8 tested 88% passed

It was requested that we get stats on all the AP classes taught at PGHS.

How many students enrolled in the courses/how many are taking the test/how many are passing

(I believe Principal Brantley was going to follow up on this)

\$8,356 carry over from previous year was used to help pay for subs so that teachers could attend conferences and get added training.

#### Goals for 2012-13

- 1- Provide AP classes and track students who take AP exams (\$31,000 allocated)
- 2- Increase graduation rates by 1%/maintain 3 advocates to help students (\$35,500 allocated)
- 3- Maintain Latinos in Action (\$11,200 allocated)
- 4- Reduce Math Class sizes (\$5.600 allocated)
