- 1. So far no new school community council members. Emily has someone who might come next month. Taran will include a call for more members via the newsletter. Tim would like other people to invite Lynn Eyestone.
- 2. Data is not available. Dr. Chun discussed school grading. Mountain View is a B school.

3. Bond discussion:

Parents: 6 million is a fixed amount, new windows, arts remodel, bathrooms, turf for football field, & possible office redo. The district is now listening to MV for priorities rather than imposing their priorities.

Dr. Chun: Parents need to push for cameras. Prior to the meeting last week, there was no build for fine arts. The build is a possibility thanks to parents asking great question.

Kristi Tonga's class will be moved to the distance learning room. Jess will use his own funding so it won't come out of our bond money. Kristi's old room will remolded to be used for practice rooms, storage space, and there will also be remodeling the rooms with fine arts in mind.

MV Priorities:

- 1. 1 million for arts build
- 2. 1 million for remodel
- 3. 1 million for Bruin Bowl
- 4. Other priorities after that
- 4. PLC Model: Support teachers with outstanding performance.

MV is going to visit Lakeridge to see them in classrooms. Our English teachers from 10^{th} and 11^{th} grade are going to watch PLC and classrooms and have a Q and A. They want to learn how to structure intervention, I have data—now what?, etc.

Mrs. Macias was interested in: Can we do a Lending Tree or other PLC process at MV where we can ask specific questions in departments? Can we have Lakeridge come and observe us and give us feedback?

Who is outlier in Math? Lone Peak scores well, but doesn't do the PLC process well.

Westlake is the outlier in Science.

5. Increase performance on ACT: Taking ACT Prep classes—Tyler Ball, Sadler-Holli,

Can we get a sub committee to help Parents, Students and teachers to help students prep for ACT?

The school is not doing ACT Plan test for sophomores this year. Can we do it in the spring?

Remediate ACT. How do we help kids study?

- 2. Has put together a common curriculum map and common pacing guide. Had a meeting last year with Lakeridge.
- 3. English PLC format:
